

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term our learning super power is 'listening'. We will be playing lots of listening games as well as introducing our 6 golden rules through stories and activities. We will be encouraging children to learn the school routines and show kindness towards each other. We will also be supporting the children in getting to know each other and make new friends.

Physical Development

We will be supporting children with their core strength and gross motor movements through our PE lessons as well as outdoor activities using large bricks and small apparatus. We will also be encouraging fine motor development through manipulating different materials, mark making and developing our pencil control, practising scissor skills, and using malleable materials.

Communication and Language

This term we will be doing lots of activities to encourage the children to talk to each other and listen to each other. We will be exploring the meaning of new words through stories and games and expanding our vocabulary as we explore the resources in our environment.

Creative Development

This term we will be exploring lots of well known nursery rhymes and new songs. We will be introducing the children to our treasured books and encouraging them to explore these stories through role play. We will also be teaching the children how to use the painting area and mix their own colours.

Mathematics

In our number work we will be singing lots of counting songs and exploring the composition of numbers to 5. We will also be exploring patterns and quantities, length, weight and capacity.

Literacy Development

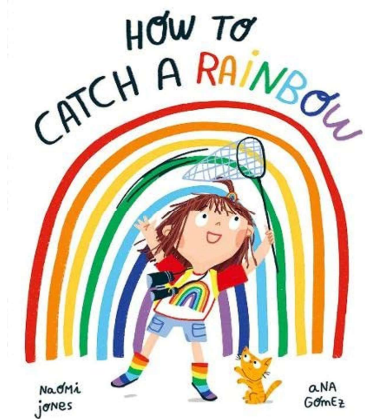

We will also be using our key texts to explore different themes around colour, art, feelings and autumn.

Understanding the World

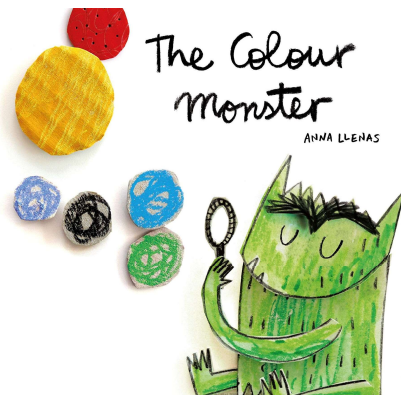

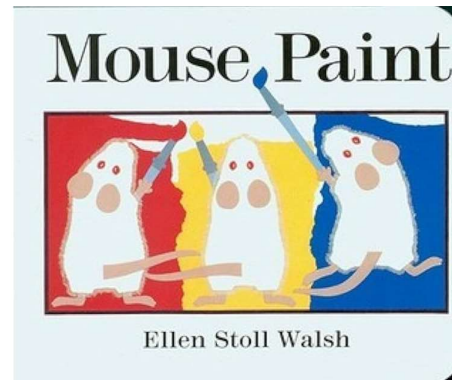

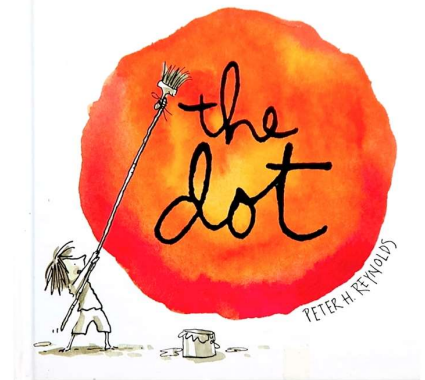
